"Ordinary resolution number 1: To appoint Mark Harris as a non-executive director of the Company", was not passed by the requisite majority of shareholders.

The number of shares voted in person or by proxy was 122 908 950, representing 89% of the total issued share capital of the same class of Cognition shares.
